Southern Africa and the world are currently facing a pandemic on a scale we have not witnessed in our lifetime before. With our countries on lockdown – the vast majority of our populations are unable to earn a living as many informal traders lost their livelihoods. This, coupled with the fact that thousands of children are not receiving their two hot meals at creches and schools daily, means that families and many communities are left destitute.

Please help us to assist as many vulnerable people as possible to access basic necessities such as food and hygiene packs in order to lower the risk of infection. Several Dioceses are in the process of setting up task teams in their Archdeaconries to assess the needs of the most marginalised in their communities. Food will be sourced online and collected by essential services identified in each Dioceses for delivery to the most vulnerable.
